## FRIENDSHIP STAR 9" BLOCK

### 1. FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- 2 4" squares light fabric A
- 2 4" squares dark fabric B
- 1-15" X 3 ½" strip light **fabric A**, cut into 4-3½" squares
- 1 − 3 ½" square dark B or or feature fabric

### 2. FABRIC CUTTING:

Using the 4" squares make 4 Half Square Triangles (HST):


Put a light 4" **Fabric A** & a dark 4" **Fabric B** square **right sides** together.

Mark the diagonal on the fabric A.

SEW  $\frac{1}{4}$ " **ON BOTH** sides of diagonal.

Cut ON the marked diagonal.

Press to dark.





#### 3. BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

Sew three rows as shown in top block photo, using the dark 3 ½" square or a feature square in the centre. Please do not trim.

However, PLEASE — USE ONLY the Northcott Stonehenge OH CANADA lines of fabric for these blocks. This makes it possible to mix blocks from across the country!

The fabric in this kit was cut to complete the pattern included. Please mark your city or region on the FRONT of the block. YES – the FRONT of the block. Your block should be mailed to the address provided with the pattern. Blocks will be gathered and grouped for a quilt top, representing as many places across Canada as we can. Quilters, quilting bees, guilds and anyone interested in completing a quilt of hugs are asked to let us know they are interested in completing a Quilt of Valour™ and we will forward a set of blocks representing several regions across the nation. You will be expected to complete the quilt, bind and label (with registered label that may be included in your package), just as you would any other Quilt of Valour. The quilt can then be forwarded to your nearest representative for presentation. The Hug Blocks from several regions of Canada wrap our injured CAF members past and present with many *quilted hugs from across the nation!!* If you wish to make a quilt from blocks of hugs, contact the email noted on the pattern a set of blocks will be sent to you.
